B. VOLUNTEER CITIZEN OF THE YEAR AWARD

- 1. The purpose of the Volunteer Citizen of the Year Award is to recognize an individual or couple whose exceptional volunteerism has enhanced the community.
- 2. Who is eligible:
 - (a) Nominees may be an individual or a couple;
 - (b) Nominees must reside in the District of Logan Lake;
 - (c) Nominees must be contributing a minimum of 25 hours per year to the community in a volunteer capacity, not as an employee of a group, organization or business and nominees must fulfill the requirements of 2 or more of the following categories:
 - i) Arts and Culture (vocal, visual arts, music, multimedia, dance and theatre/drama);
 - ii) Service and Caregiving (volunteered in local charities, non-profit groups or organizations);
 - iii) Environmental (contributed to the community's environmental health and or public environmental awareness);
 - iv) Sports and Recreation (promotes health and fitness or has excelled in athletics or demonstrates quality team building, cooperation and leadership);
 - v) Personal Triumph (surmounted obstacles with optimism and hope and who has demonstrated perseverance, determination and a passion for life).
- 3. Written nominations will be accepted up until and including June 2nd annually, at the Tourism Centre or at the District Office, #1 Opal Drive, Box 190, Logan Lake, BC V0K 1W0, on the Nomination Form referenced as Appendix "2".
- 4. A Selection Committee consisting of two (2) Council members, the previous Citizen of the Year recipient, or alternate citizen chosen by the Business Association and the Tourism Manager, shall review and determine the recipient of the Annual Volunteer Citizen of the Year Award by June 2nd each year, based on the eligibility requirements outlined in 2(c) above.
- 5. The Annual Volunteer Citizen of the Year Award shall be presented in conjunction with the Flag raising ceremony during the third week of June each year.
