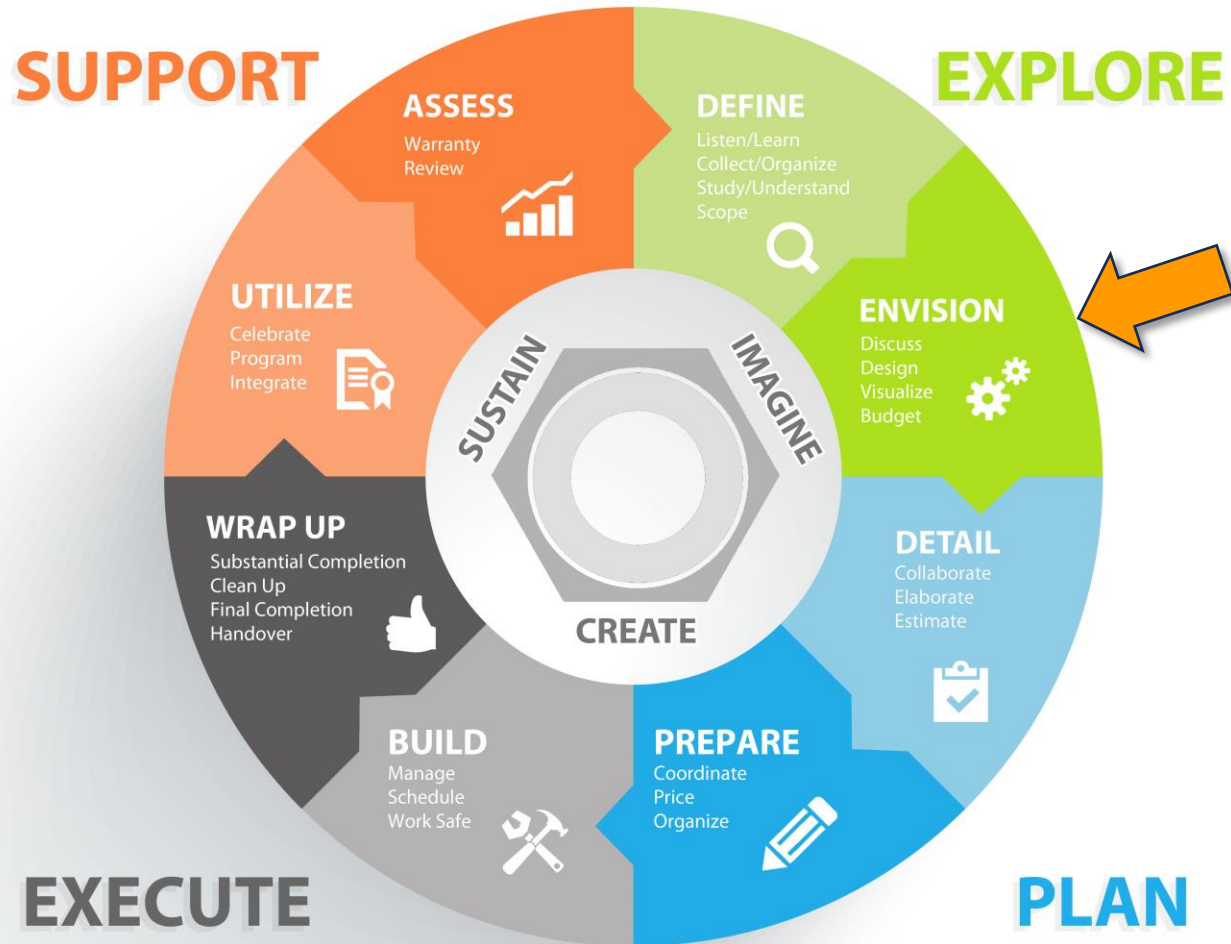

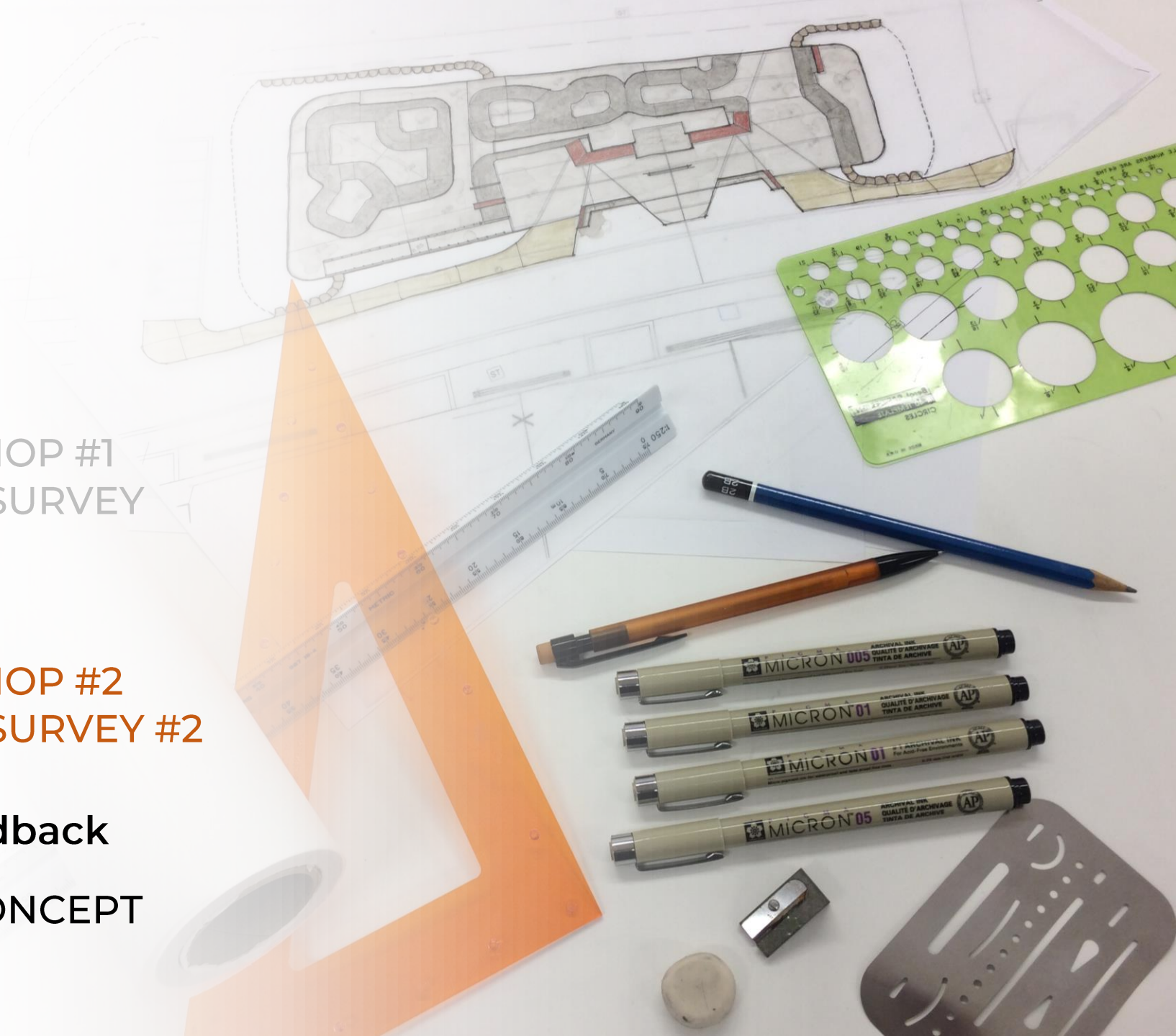

46% of online participants selected Maggs Park as the future location of Logan Lake Skatepark

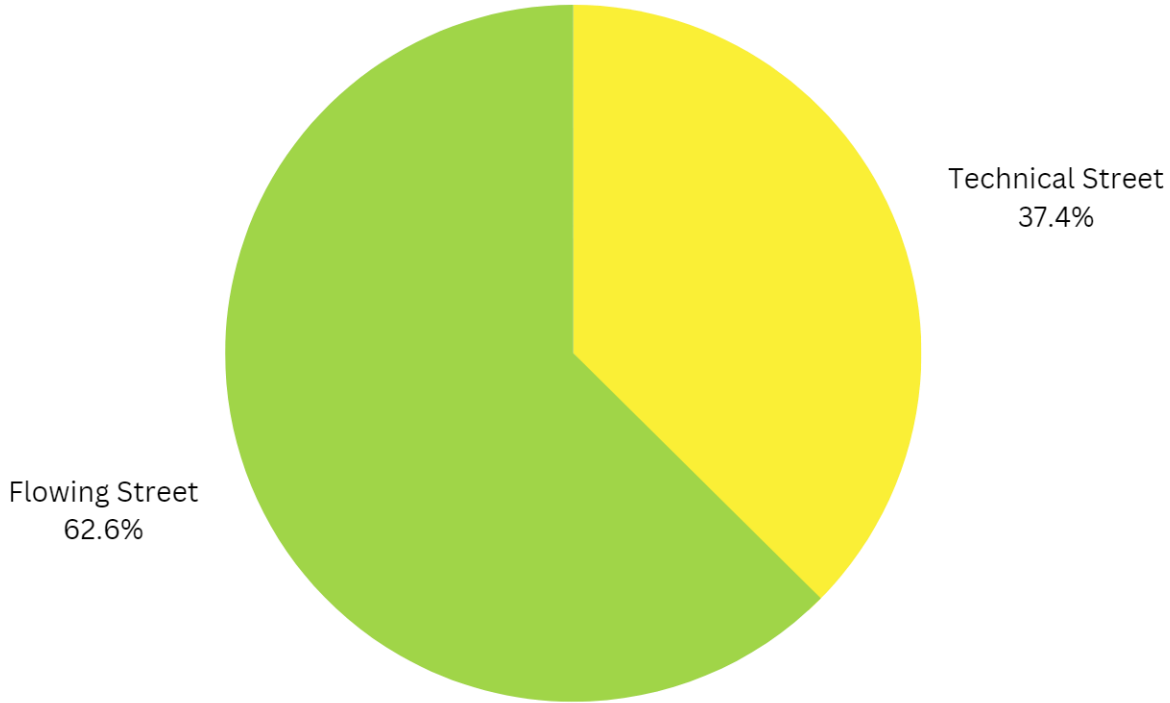

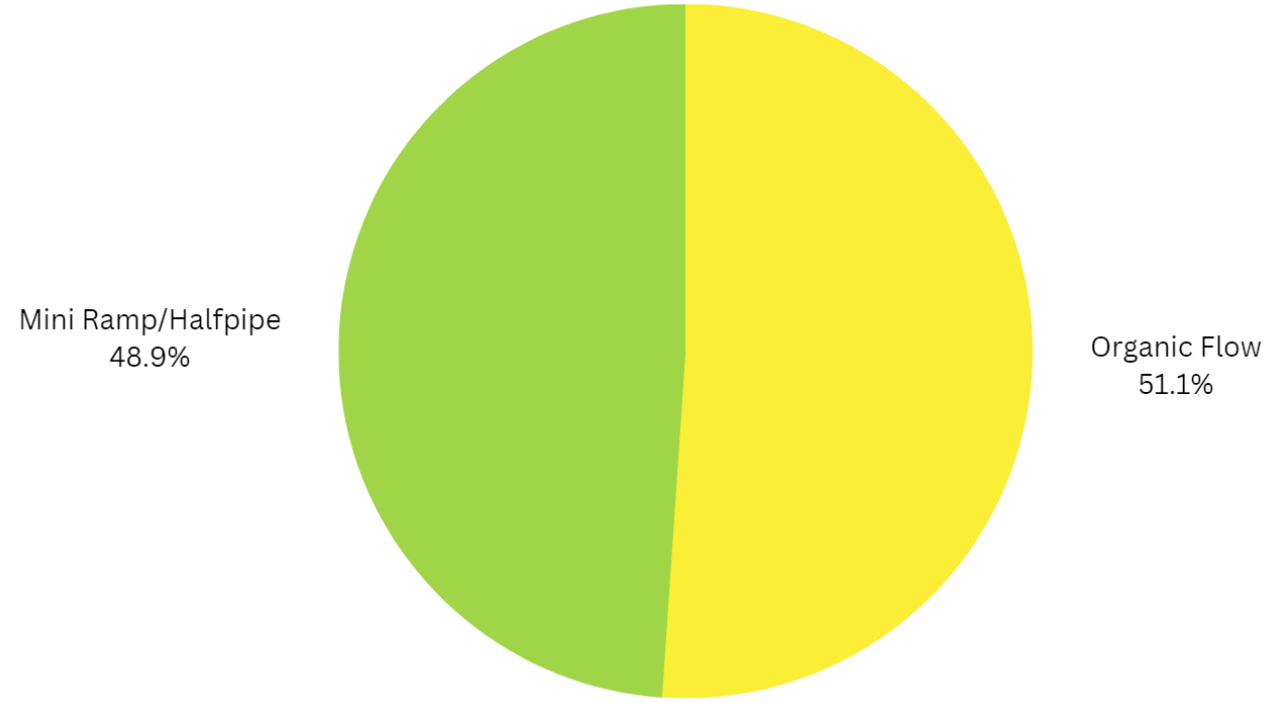

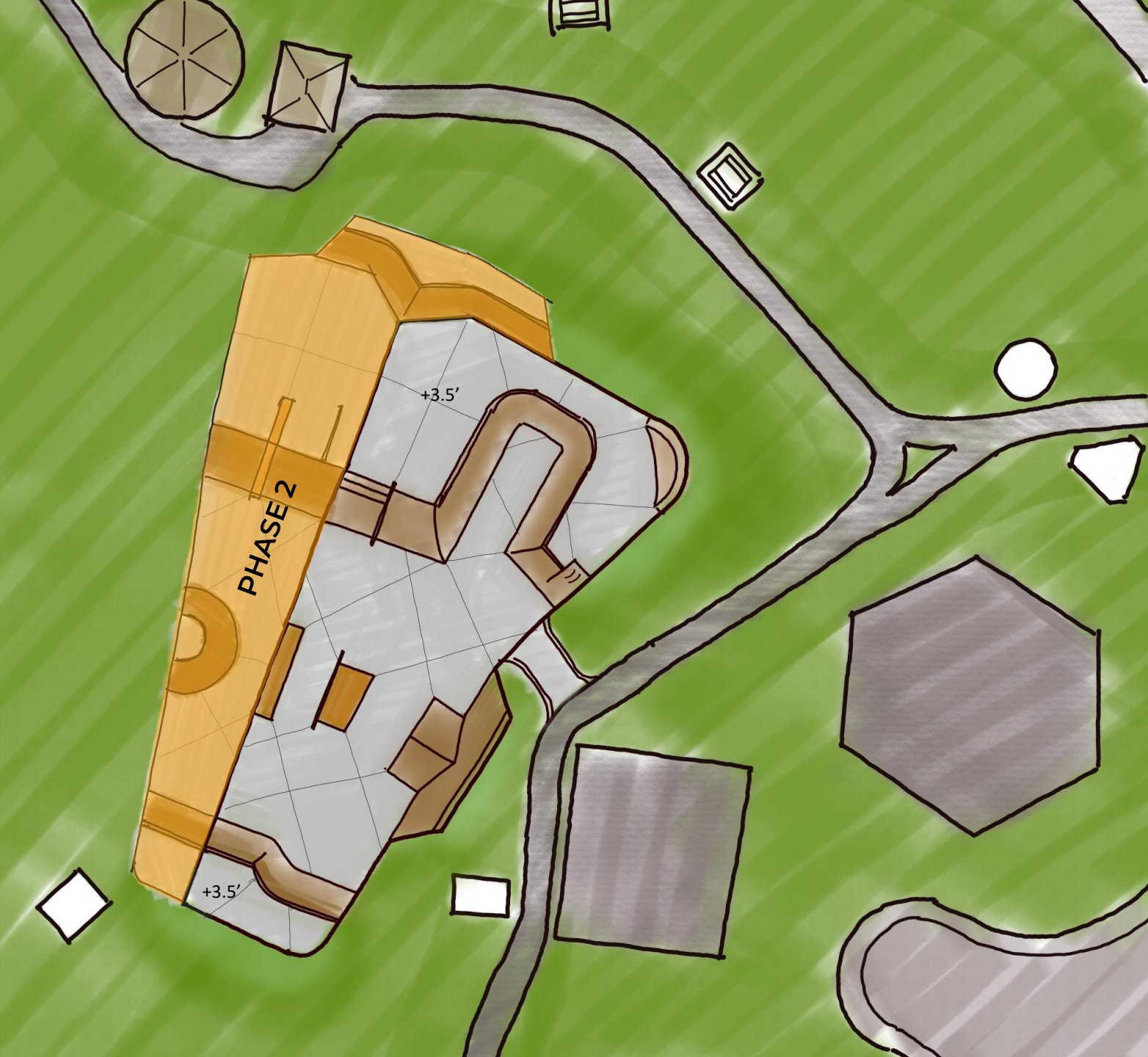


PREFERRED STYLE OF BOWL TERRAIN

OPTION 1

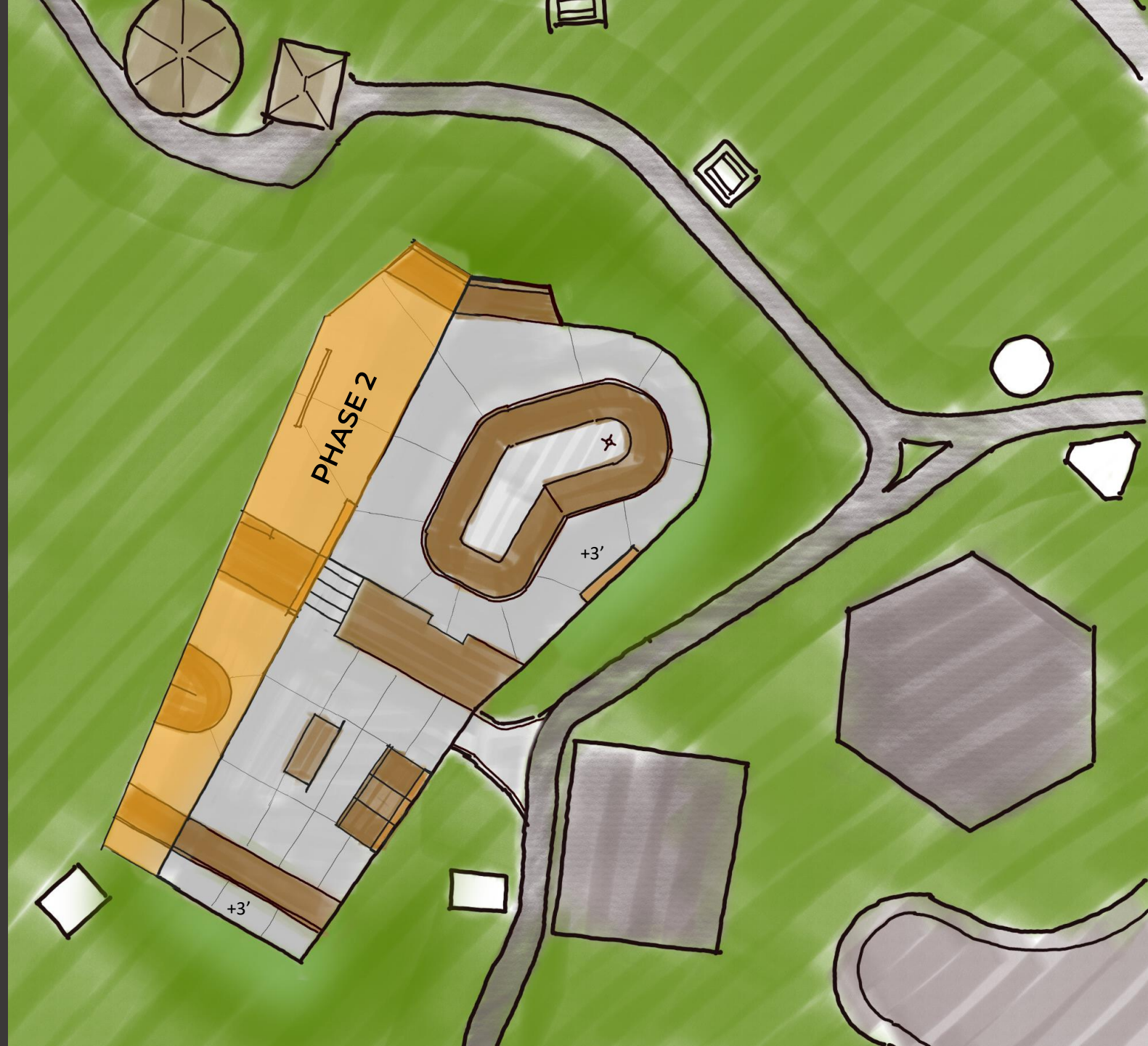
Miniramp and flowing street with euro-gap, dowl rail, flat ledge, manual pad with rail combo, and wedge-to-wedge in slappy bank

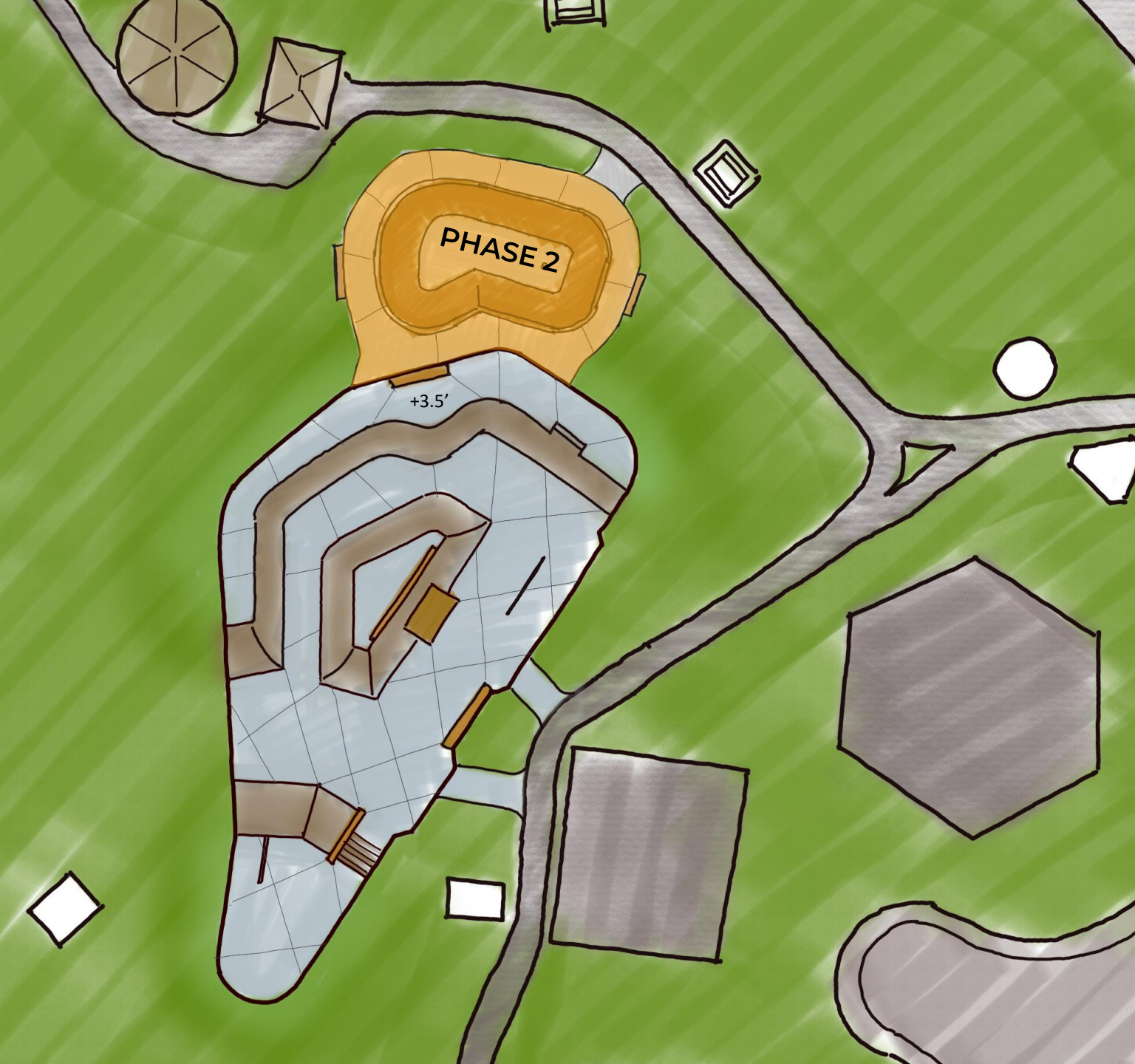
Phase 2 adds hip feature, hubba ledge, bank-to-bar, and half bank volcano

OPTION 2

Enclosed bowl and small street section with stair set and funbox. 4-6ft deep bowl.

Phase 2 adds hubba ledge, euro gap, slappy curb, wedge bump



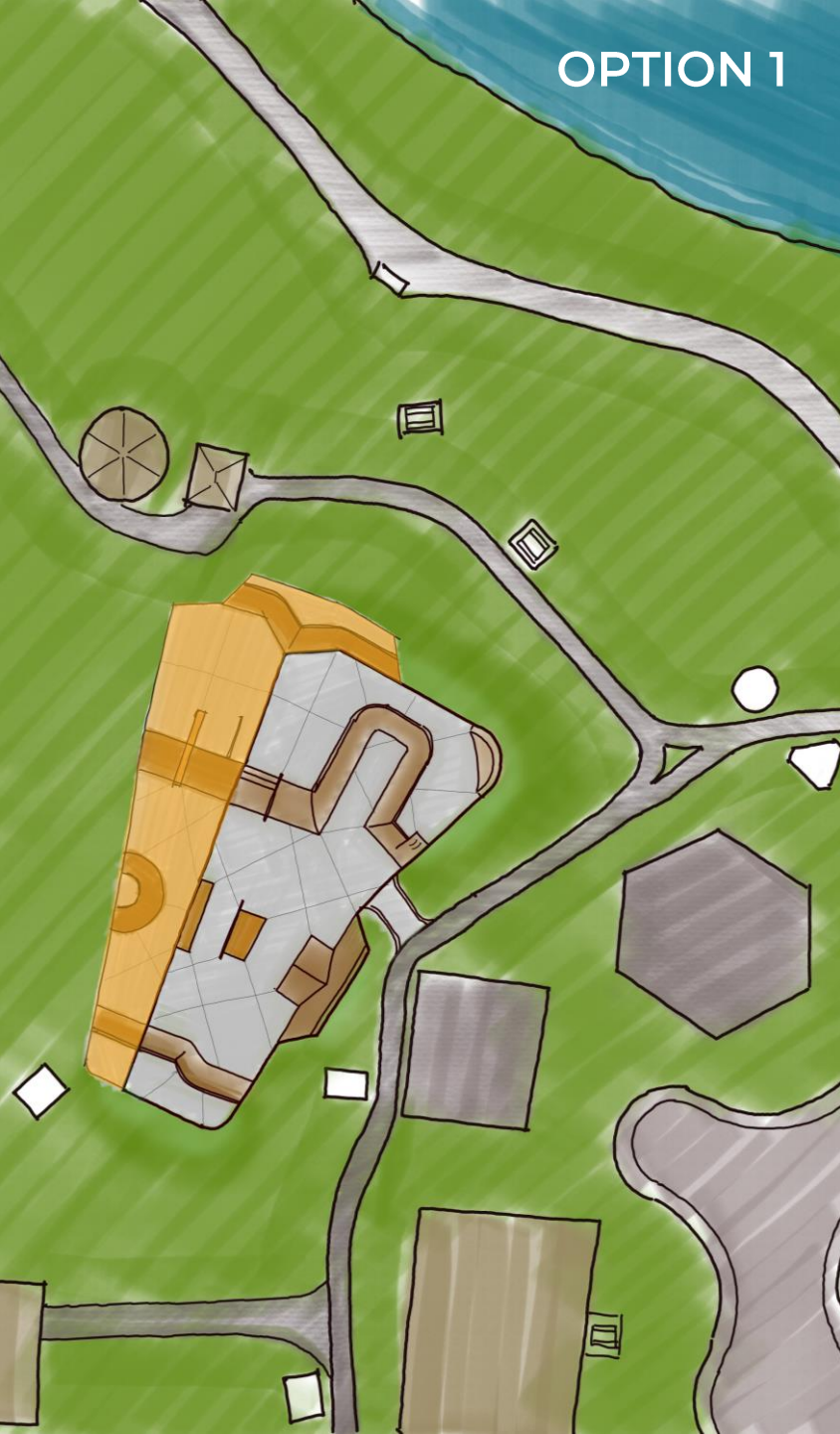


OPTION 3

Flow transition lane and tech street lane with stair set, hubba, flat ledge, rail and manual pad in slappy wall to curb

Phase 2 adds small flow bowl 4-5ft deep

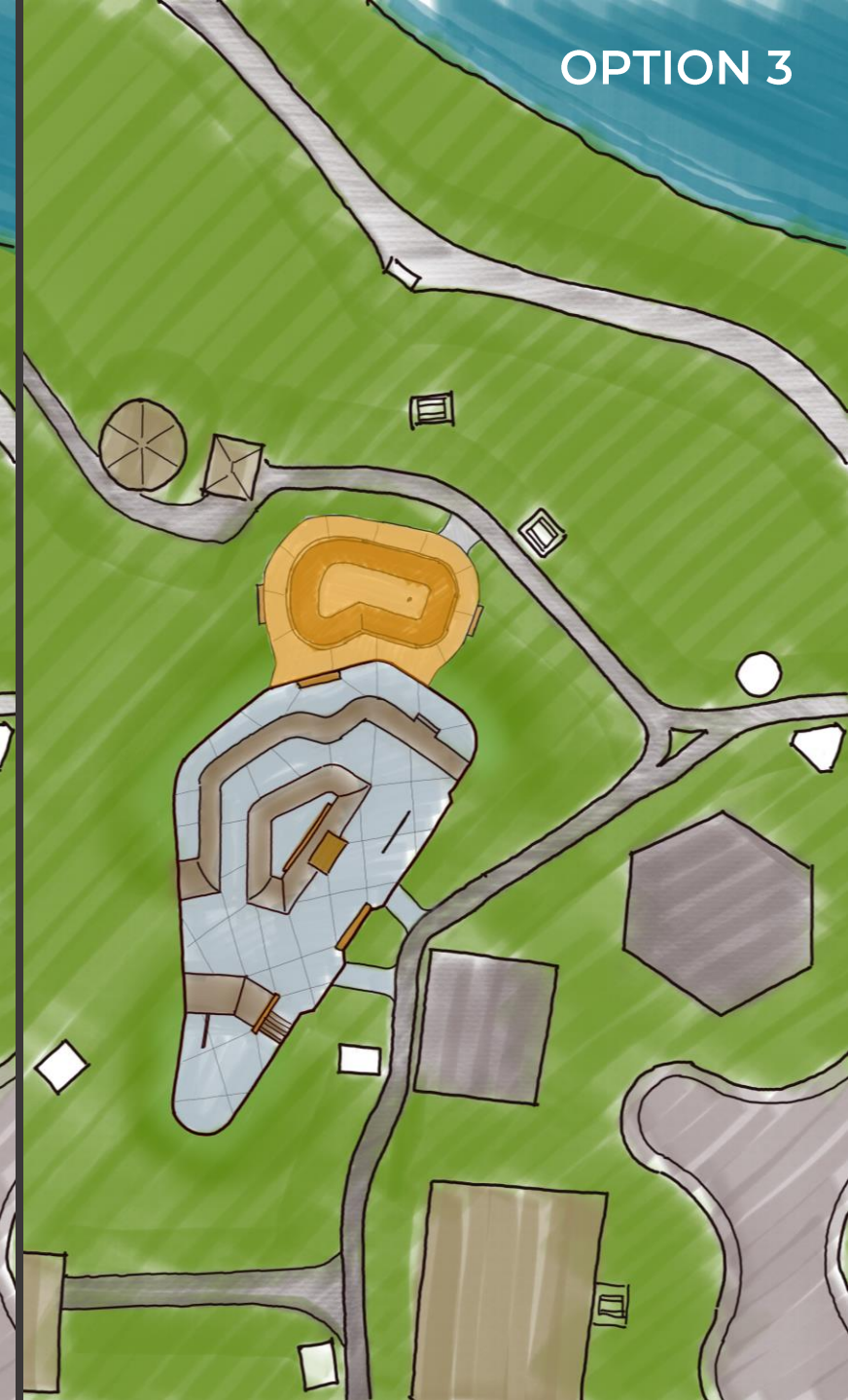
