

## **Equipment Operator IV (Casual) Job Posting**

Applications will be received by the undersigned until 4:00pm, January 18, 2024, for the position of Public Works – Casual Employee - Equipment Operator IV (CUPE Local 900). Casual employees are employed on an “on-call” basis to cover absences due to health leave, vacation, special leave or any other approved leave.

Reporting to the Director of Public Works and Recreation and the Public Works Lead Hand, the Public Works Casual - Equipment Operator IV, is responsible for the operation of all vehicles and equipment owned and operated by the District. In addition, the Equipment Operator IV shall perform duties including general maintenance of utility system (water and sewer), roads and street maintenance including street sweeping, snow removal, new construction and repair, parks maintenance and other duties as assigned.

Work will involve operation of District vehicles and equipment such as backhoe, loader, dump trucks, snowplows, grass cutting equipment, power tools, light duty vehicles, garbage collection system vehicles, etc. and may include grader, street sweeper, snow blower and other District vehicles and/or equipment.

### **Job Duties Include:**

- Operation of District vehicles and equipment including backhoe, loaders, dump trucks, snow plow, mowers, tractors, light duty vehicles, etc.
- Performs preventative maintenance of all equipment.
- General repairs to municipal utility systems (including water and sewer breaks, utility system malfunctions and system repairs, maintenance, and improvements).
- General maintenance of roads, streets and parks including snow removal, asphalt repair, concrete work, street sweeping.
- General maintenance of parks including grass cutting, parks and equipment maintenance, irrigation systems maintenance, new facility construction, fence line repairs.
- All other duties as assigned.

### **Job Qualifications:**

- Grade XII or equivalent.
- Aptitude and ability to operate all District vehicles and equipment.
- Experience and proficiency in all facets of municipal operations.
- Class 5 BC Drivers License with Airbrakes endorsement.
