Work will involve assisting in all facets of the Public Works Department, including road and sidewalk maintenance, fence line repairs, parks maintenance, water and sewer system maintenance and other duties assigned.

- Experience and proficiency in all facets of municipal operations.
- Class 5 BC Drivers License with air brake endorsement.

## Job Duties Include:

- Operation of Class III equipment.
- Assisting with construction projects.
