## A. VOLUNTEER YOUTH AWARD

- 1. The purpose of the Youth Award is to recognize outstanding youth, their volunteerism and/or contributions to the community.
- 2. Who is eligible:
  - (a) Nominees must be between the ages of 13 and 18;
  - (b) Nominees must reside in the District of Logan Lake;
  - (c) Nominees must contribute a minimum of 12 hours volunteer community service per year, via participation in a community non-profit group, organization or program, community clean-up, mentoring youth, etc. and nominees must fulfill the requirements of 3 or more of the following categories:
    - i) Arts and Culture (vocal, visual arts, music, multimedia, dance and theatre/drama);
    - ii) Service and Caregiving (volunteered in local charities, non-profit groups or organizations);
    - iii) Entrepreneurship (demonstrated initiative and creativity through designing and successfully initiating his or her own business or developing an innovative product or service);
    - iv) Environmental (contributed to the community's environmental health and or public environmental awareness);
    - v) Leadership (shown significant and continuing leadership in a way that improves the quality of life and encourages others);
    - vi) Sports and Recreation (promotes health and fitness or has excelled in athletics or demonstrates quality team building, cooperation and leadership);
    - vii) Personal Triumph (surmounted obstacles with optimism and hope and who has demonstrated perseverance, determination, and a passion for life).
- 3. Written nominations will be accepted up until **4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>**, at the Municipal Office, #1 Opal Drive, Box 190, Logan Lake, BC V0K 1W0, on the Nomination Form referenced as Appendix "1".
- 4. A Selection Committee consisting of two (2) Council members, one (1) youth (as appointed by the Grad Committee) and the Community Development Officer, shall review and determine the recipient of the Annual Youth Award after the deadline, based on the eligibility requirements outlined in 2(c) above.
- 5. The Annual Youth Award shall be presented in conjunction with the Flag Raising Ceremony.
