Logan Lake Citizens on Patrol (COP) Code of Conduct

I understand that, as a Citizens on Patrol Program volunteer, I am responsible to conduct myself with ethics and integrity. In doing so, I will foster public trust, respect and appreciation for the Program.

I acknowledge and agree to:

- Conduct myself in a manner that reflects positively upon the Program
- Never act or fail to act in contravention of the law during the course of my volunteer duties
- Treat all volunteers and the public with respect
- Be truthful and honest at all times
- Report to the COP Program Coordinator any dishonest or improper act that compromises the integrity of the Program
- Never retaliate against any volunteer who reports a dishonest or improper act
- Never disclose information that is or may be confidential without prior approval of the program coordinator or police
- Never accept personal rewards, privileges, benefits or gifts that may create a real or perceived conflict of interest
- Never report for duty if my mental state or abilities may be impaired
- Value diversity and never discriminate on the basis of race, religion, colour, creed, age, marital status, national origin, ancestry, gender, sexual preference, medical condition, physical or mental barrier, or family
- Never harass, intimidate or threaten fellow volunteers or the public and report the actions of other volunteers who engage in such behaviour
- Take steps to avoid placing myself or others in danger, including following all safety and operational guidelines and training
- Never use the Program logo or other identifying mark except in the course of authorized duties
- Turn in all records, including notebooks when complete or when my tenure with the Program ends
- Immediately report to the program coordinator any change in my status, including any investigation, charge, conviction or breach of the laws that may affect my status with the Program
