**Snow Removal**

5. Council referred Committee budget allocations to Budget Discussions;
6. Council approved Staff to review and simplify nomination criteria and schedule of the Citizen of the Year and Flag Raising Day Policy; and to re-consider the annual Volunteer Gala;
7. Council approved Staff to provide a report regarding updates and maintenance of the District website including integration of the Facts and Info Bulletin;
8. Council approved the Tremont Creek and FireSmart Book, including all reports, be referred to the Tremont Wildfire Committee;
