1. The District will accept residential septage tank sludge from those residential properties within the area know as "the acreages", who are not connected to the municipal sewer system subject to the following:
a) A Septage Dumping Permit [(g) below], must be completed; approved by the Public Works Superintendent; and presented on site prior to dumping;
b) Only one Septage Dumping Permit per residential property per year, is permitted;
c) The Septage Dumping Permit fee is $\$ 125.00$;
d) Residential septage must meet the Sewer Quality regulations as identified in Sanitary Sewer Bylaw 214, Section 23;
e) Dumping is only permitted between regular working hours Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.;
f) Illegal dumping will result in a charge for cost of recovery, to the Septage Dumping Permit holder.
