ELECTOR REGISTRATION

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- a) I am a Canadian citizen;
- b) I am 18 years of age or older on general voting day October 15, 2022;
- c) I have been a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration (at time of voting);
- d) I am a resident of the District of Logan Lake on the day registered to vote;
- e) I am not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or assent voting and am not otherwise disqualified by law.

To register, resident electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

To register, non-resident property electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the other property owners.

MAIL BALLOT VOTING

REQUESTING A MAIL BALLOT PACKAGE

This Election, Mail Ballot Voting is available for resident electors and non-resident property electors. Registration for a Mail Ballot Voting Package will be between September 28th and October 12th, 2022. (by mail, telephone, fax or email to districtofloganlake@loganlake.ca):

- (1) Full name,
- (2) Residential address,
- (3) Address of the property in relation to which you are voting (for non-resident property electors),
- (4) Method of delivery of your mail ballot package:
 - (a) pick up at District of Logan Lake office, OR
 - (b) regular letter mail through Canada Post to residential address, time permitting OR
 - (c) regular letter mail through Canada Post to an alternate address that you provide when requesting the ballot package, *time permitting*,
- (5) If you are not on the list of electors, to ensure you receive the correct registration application form in your package, you must indicate whether you are going to be registering as a resident or non-resident property elector.

If we receive your application after October 7th the time may be insufficient for mailing and receipt of the ballot; we recommend that you arrange to pick up your mail ballot package from the municipal office. Application Forms can be found on our website at https://loganlake.ca/your-municipal-elections/, or can be picked up at the Municipal Office.

The District of Logan Lake will prepare and mail ballot packages commencing on or about October 3, 2022. To be counted for the election, you are responsible to ensure your mail ballot is received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 8:00 p.m. on October 15, 2022.
